4 Process Before the Entrance Examination

- 1) Please be sure to attend the school information session for students requiring Japanese language support (held on Saturday, November 7, 2026, and Saturday, December 5, 2026). Please apply via the school website.
- 2) After the information session, a pre-interview will be held for students who wish to take the examination. Please apply for the pre-interview through your junior high school teacher.

About the Pre-Interview

- 1) Date: After the school information session on Saturday, November 7, 2026, or Saturday, December 5, 2026
- 2) Location: KENKOKU High School
- 3) Participants: Applicant, parent/guardian, and school representative
- 4) Notes:
 - Attendance at the school information session and completion of the pre-interview are required in order to apply.
 - If these conditions are not met, you cannot take the entrance examination for our school.
 - In the pre-interview, we will confirm your intention to enroll and your language level.
 - If possible, please have a teacher from your current junior high school attend the pre-interview.
 - After the pre-interview, be sure to inform your school teacher whether you intend to take our entrance examination.

6 Examination Subjects

- Japanese, English, and Essay
 - Japanese: A test to confirm Japanese proficiency (approximately JLPT N4 level)
 - English: You may choose the English version, Chinese version, or Japanese version with furigana.
 - Essay: May be written in English, Chinese, or Japanese.
 - * No special measures such as extended examination time or bringing dictionaries will be provided.
- Interview (conducted in English, Chinese, or Japanese)

7 Single-Choice / Concurrent Applications

Both are accepted.

* If the number of single-choice applicants reaches 16 people concurrent applications may not be accepted.
